

BGHS – Physical Education Department Grading Policy

Daily Participation

Students earn 10 points every day for full participation. Anything less than full participation will result in less than 10 points for that day. Total participation will be approximately 900 points based on the average length of a semester.

Students are required to dress for PE class every day. Students that forget their gym uniform will participate in their street clothes and will lose half of their participation points. Continued no dresses will result in disciplinary action.

For each day a student is not dressed in an approved PE uniform, they will lose their 5 of their 10 participation points for that day. Students that are absent from class must make up the class period to earn the points. Points per zero are progressive:

Unexcused Absences

1 st absence	-10 points
2 nd absence	-20 points
3 rd absence	-30 points
4 th absence	-40 points
subsequent absences	-50 points

Excused Absences

1 st – 10 th absence	-10 points
11 th absence	-20 points
12 th absence	-30 points
13 th absence	-40 points
subsequent absences	-50 points

Absences can be made up for full credit up to 2 weeks after the absence.

All students will be required to dress for gym every day unless they have an approved medical waiver. A parent note is acceptable for 3 consecutive days of medical waiver. After the third day, a doctors note will be required to get an approved medical waiver from PE participation. Copies of all doctors notes are to be provided to the PE teacher and the school nurse. Teachers will note any modified workout conditions on a students CV card.

Teachers will submit updated grades on a weekly basis providing students and parents an awareness of current progress.

Required CV's

Each student is assigned a required number of CV's that need to be completed during the course of the semester. The number of CV's required per student will be determined by their fitness score. Scoring of CV's are an all or nothing score. If a student is current in their required CV's, they will earn full # of points for the semester. If they fall behind in their CV's this grade will change to a Zero until they get back on pace with their required CV's.
