Township High School District 214 believes that it has the responsibility to provide activities that are interesting, wholesome, stimulating and enjoyable for all students. The above listed activities are those that are offered by Buffalo Grove High School and are covered by the District's No pass/No play policy and thus subject to the District's co-curricular participation fee.

Students who participate in the student activities program will understand the value of the activities program while demonstrating responsibility. They will contribute to the school and community, demonstrate leadership skills and enhance and sustain their self-esteem.

To ensure the proper atmosphere for participating in activities, the student and parent/guardian must understand and cooperate in helping to establish this condition by adhering to all school rules and regulations. When a violation of school rules occurs, proper steps will be taken. A student may be suspended or dropped from the activity for the remainder of the season for violating the co-curricular code, failure to follow rules set for the specific activity, or non-compliance with the Illinois High School Association guidelines.

A student must have his/her parent's/guardian's permission to participate. For interscholastic competition, the student is required to abide by the IHSA by-laws on eligibility. Prominent among these by-laws is the scholastic standing requirement that states "every student must be passing 25 credit hours of high school work per week, must have passed 25 credit hours the previous semester, and the student must be living with a legal guardian".

As a participant or guardian of a participant in the co-curricular program, I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury in certain activities. I acknowledge that even with the best coaching, use of the most protective equipment, and strict observance of rules, injuries to my son/daughter are still possible. I recognize that on rare occasions these injuries to my son/daughter could be severe and could result in total disability, paralysis or even death. I approve that certified staff members may administer emergency first aid. Further, I approve of my son's/daughter's travel to and from these activities during the current school year.
